JOB OVERVIEW

Applications are open for suitably qualified Art Technicians to join Scotch College. The position of Art Technician is responsible for assisting with art processes, preparing for lessons, cleaning up after lessons and displaying artworks in the Junior School, Years 1-5 or the Senior School, Years 8-10.

The workload for these positions is 15 hours per week in the Junior School and 15 hours per week in the Senior School during term time. Applicants are welcome to apply to work in either campus or both campuses.

Our ideal candidate/s will possess skills in ceramics, metalwork, woodwork and digital technology along with a proactive attitude to support teachers with testing materials and creating prototypes. Professional presentation and the ability to communicate with diverse members of the College community is also essential.

The successful candidate/s will need proof of, or be eligible to undertake, a Department of Education National Criminal Check (Police Clearance) and a Working with Children Clearance prior to commencing employment.
