JOB DESCRIPTION

The principal requirement of this position is to support the Outdoor Education department in the provision of outdoor pursuits at Scotch College. This may include assisting with students walking on the Bibbulmun Track and/or other outdoor pursuits from Scotch College in Swanbourne or from the Moray Outdoor Education Centre in Dwellingup (as directed). This position is for a person of character who is dedicated and passionate about outdoor education.

Responsible to: Head of Outdoor Education

Main Duties:

- Assist in the facilitation of practical expeditions run by the Outdoor Education department including, Bibbulmun Track expeditions and extended expeditions at Moray (requiring time away from home)
- Maintenance of Moray our outdoor education facility, in Dwellingup
- Maintenance of outdoor education equipment and storeroom

Required Qualifications & Clearances:

- Current Wilderness First Aid Certificate (or ability to complete prior to commencement)
- Working with Children Check
- Department of Education Police Clearance

Desirable Qualifications & Clearances:

- Australian Canoeing Awards Canoe/Kayak or Equivalent
- Swiftwater Rescue Technician Level 1, Bronze Medallion and Surf Lifesaving Bronze Medallion
- NOLRS Registered- Abseiling Artificial and Natural Surfaces
- NOLRS Registered- Bushwalking in Difficult and Trackless areas
- Heavy Vehicle Driving Licence with an F Class endorsement.

Note: Where an applicant qualifies, he/she will be required to enrol as a trainee under the National Training Scheme where rebates will cover their enrolment in TAFE for a Cert III in Outdoor Recreation. This will be assessed in conjunction with Central TAFE and the Head of Outdoor Education.
