JOB OVERVIEW

Scotch College has an opportunity for an enthusiastic and experienced Mathematics Teacher to cover maternity leave commencing early March 2016 and concluding at the end of Term 3, 2016. The position will be between 0.4 – 0.6 FTE.

The position involves teaching within the Mathematics learning area in Years 9- 10. The successful applicant will have a comprehensive understanding of the WA curriculum.

Applicants should be able to demonstrate outstanding levels of achievement in Mathematics teaching, regardless of experience. They should also be able to demonstrate their enthusiasm for and commitment to improving student outcomes and working within a cohesive and motivated faculty.

The successful candidate must have:

- A Mathematics teaching background
- A high level of WA curriculum knowledge and an ability to impart this knowledge to students effectively
- Relevant knowledge to plan, deliver and assess the teaching and learning curriculum
- Exceptional communication, presentation and teamwork skills
- The ability to build strong relationships with students, staff, parents and members of the broader College community

The successful candidate will be required to provide evidence of current registration with the Teacher's registration Board of Western Australia and a Working with Children Clearance.
