

FIRST XVIII COACH - FOOTBALL

JOB OVERVIEW

Scotch College has an exciting opportunity for an experienced Football Coach to join the Sport Department at Scotch College. The 1st XVIII coach is responsible for the 1st XVIII side during the football season, which spans from April to September, providing technical support to the players on training, recovery and match days.

The successful applicant will be highly motivated, have demonstrated football coaching experience and the ability to communicate effectively with players and coaching colleagues.

The 1st XVIII Coach of Football will be required to attend all 1st XVIII trainings, recovery sessions and matches. Trainings are Tuesday and Thursday afternoons, matches are on Saturdays. Some additional hours will be required during the season. The 1st XVIII coach will be required to attend and assist in the organisation of an annual camp or football tour.

The successful candidate will need proof of, or be eligible to undertake, a Department of Education National Criminal Check or National Police Clearance and a Working with Children Clearance prior to commencing employment.
