JOB OVERVIEW

Scotch College has the opportunity for a skilled and organised Media Technician to join the Creative Arts Department. This is a part-time position providing technical assistance to media teachers and students in the Scotch College Senior School.

The position is 20 hours per fortnight during term time, with the hours ideally being worked over two days per week. We have a view to commence this role for Term 2, 2017.

Our ideal candidate will;

- have or be working towards a tertiary qualification in media or a relevant discipline
- be a self-motivated individual with the ability to manage their time independently
- have a sound understanding of Apple Mac computers and associated software
- have previous experience in a production environment and using associated media technology
- have the ability to correctly store, organise and maintain media equipment and resources

Availability to initially work Mondays and Fridays during terms is highly desirable.
