The successful candidate will have:

- qualifications in Mathematics;
- a Mathematics teaching background;
- a high level of WA curriculum knowledge and an ability to impart this knowledge to students effectively;
- relevant knowledge to plan, deliver and assess the teaching and learning curriculum;
- competent digital technology skills to enhance teaching and learning;
- the ability to create an environment of active and genuine learning;
- exceptional communication, presentation and teamwork skills; and
- the ability to build strong relationships with students, staff, parents and members of the broader College community.
